Everything You Need to Know About EMV Technology

The nationwide EMV migration is well underway, but what does that mean for you? Here's what you need to know:

Chip-enabled cards come equipped with EMV technology, which stands for Europay, MasterCard and VISA. They come embedded with a super-small computer chip that's extremely hard to counterfeit. Compared to the standard magnetic-stripe cards you've used in the past, these chip-enabled cards offer much greater security and fraud protection.

Using a chip-enabled card is a bit different from using a standard magnetic-stripe card. Instead of swiping your card through a card reader, you'll insert or dip the chip end of your card into the bottom of the point-of-sale terminal and leave it there for the entire transaction as the reader and the card "communicate."

Chip cards still feature magnetic stripes too, so if you need to make a purchase at a store that's not prepared to accept chip card payments yet, you can still swipe your chip card the old-fashioned way.
